
Those Needing Our Prayers & Visits


Galatians 5.16 & 19-24

16 So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful flesh nature...

19 The acts of the sinful flesh nature are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; 20 idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions 21 and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God.

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

24 Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the sinful nature with its passions and desires.



Scriptures Indicating That God Lives In Us...

Acts 2.38

38 "Repent and be baptised, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

1 John 3.24 & 4.13

24 Those who obey his commands live in Him, and He in them. And this is how we know that He lives in us: We know it by the Spirit He gave us. 13 We know that we live in Him and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit.

1 Corinthians 3.16 & 2 Corinthians 6.16

16 Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit lives in you? 16 What agreement is there between the temple of God and idols? For we are the temple of the Living God. As God has said: "I will Live with them and Walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be My people."

Romans 8.9 & 12-17

9 You are controlled not by the sinful flesh nature but by the Spirit, if the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Christ. 12 Therefore, we have an obligation—but it is not to the sinful flesh nature, to live according to it. 14 because those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. 15 For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father." 16 The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children. 17 If we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ.
