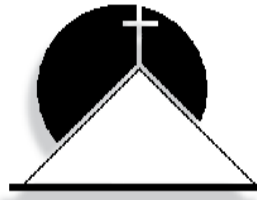

Mitchell Whittington will be going to South America July 12th–27th. If you would like to help in this Mission Effort, make your check to the church and mark it "South America."

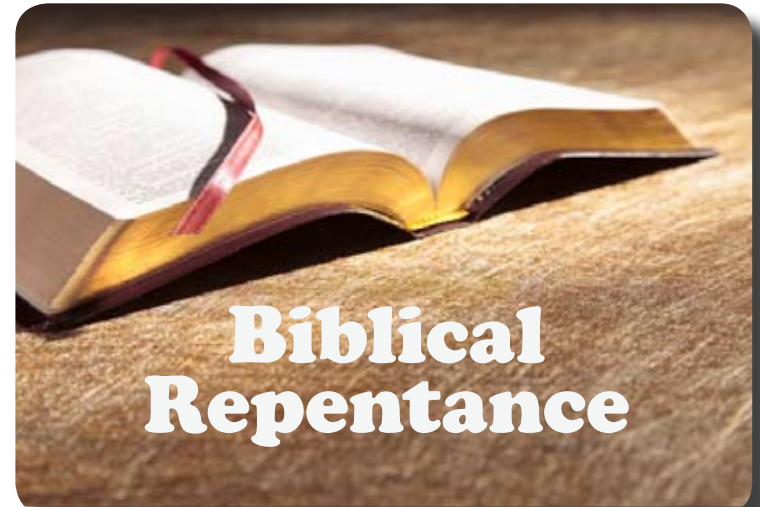
